These have been summarised below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Many parents made comments that they are delighted with the progress their children have made.</li> <li>• Parents identified that behaviour in school is very good. A few parents raised concerns about the behaviour of one or two children and requested that the school takes serious actions to manage these children.</li> <li>• Many parents commented that they were pleased that the school has provided more opportunities to update parents on their children's learning during this year. Parents identified the open days, welcome meetings and target sheets as examples of support that the school has provided. Opinions varied about the time and regularity of these sessions- some parents would like them in the evening and others requested more events in the school day.</li> <li>• Many comments gave positive feedback on the care that children receive in school and how positive relationships are at Allesley Hall.</li> <li>• A couple of parents requested that we offer sessions for the more able children as well as continuing to provide the same level of support for the less able children.</li> <li>• A few parents expressed their desire to get more feedback on developments in school explaining how these items have been actioned.</li> </ul>
