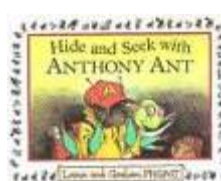
Minibeasts

We have read many books about minibeasts.

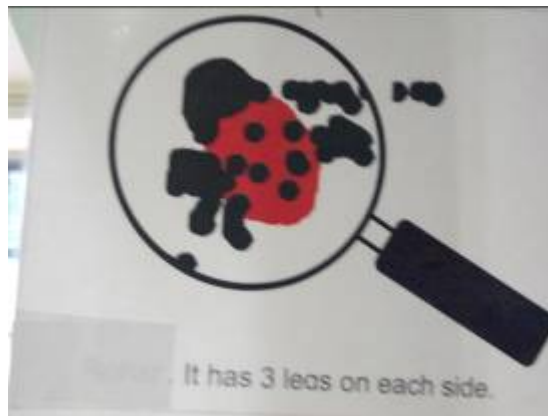




We read the story about 'Anthony Ant'. We did an investigation to find out what ants like to eat most. We also made an ant farm.
