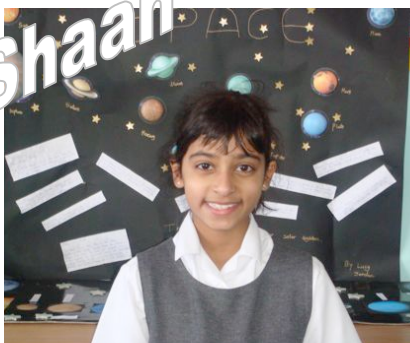
My favourite part of the day was when we watched the theatre show. It was really dark and at times it felt like we were moving.
